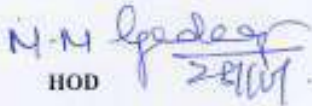

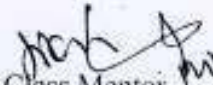

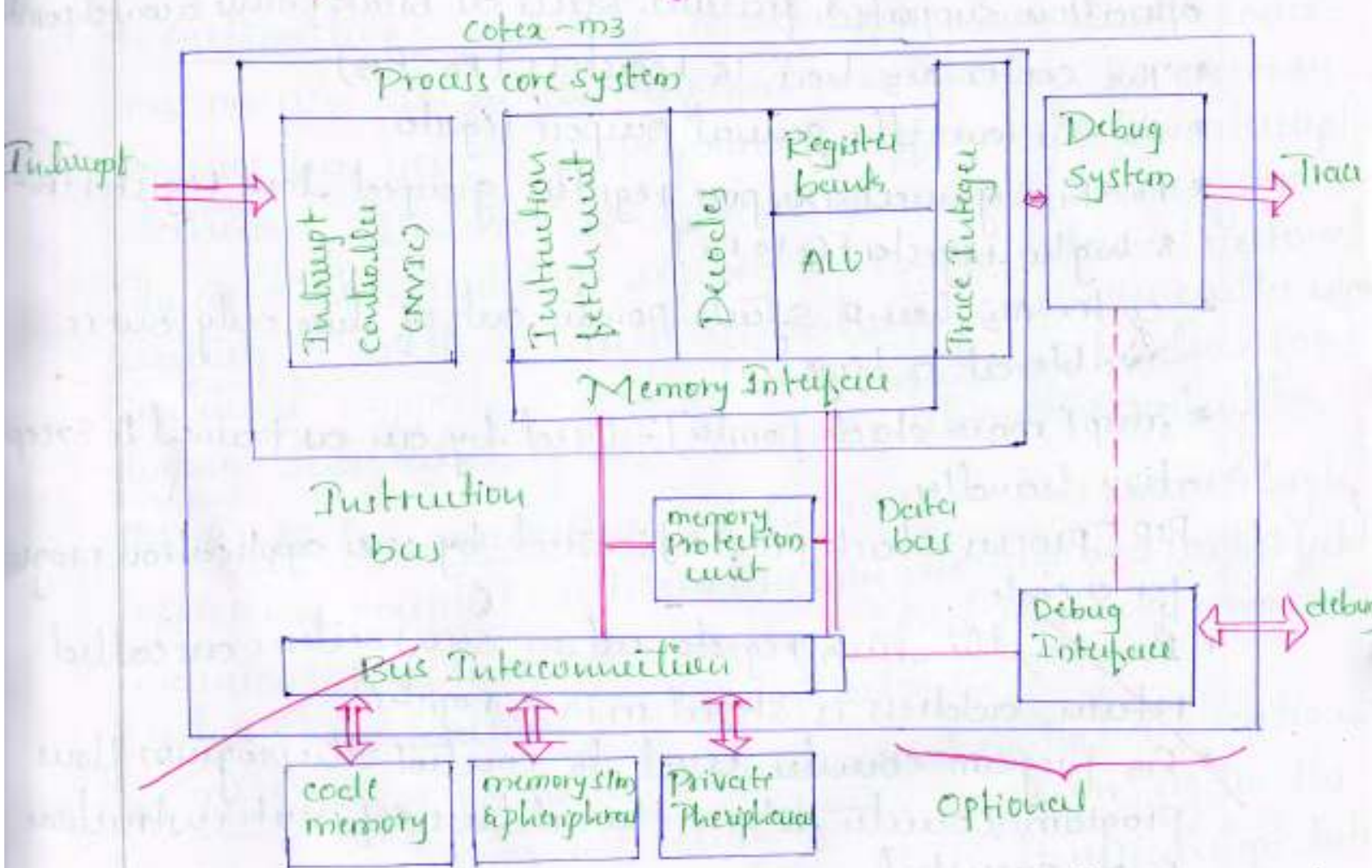

- 1) Explain the architecture of ARM cortex-M3 processor with the help of neat block diagram.



- * The cortex-M3 is a 32 bit microprocessor. It has a 32-bit datapath, 32-bit register banks, & a 32 bit memory interface.
- * The processor has a harvard architecture, which means that it has a separate instruction bus & data bus & 8KB memory space.
- * Both Big Endian & little Endian memory systems are supported.
- * Complex applications that require more memory system feat-ure. the cortex-M3 processor has an optional memory protection unit.

- * The Cortex M3 processor includes a no of components internal debugging components. These components provided debugging operation supports & features. Such as break points & watchpoints.
- * The Cortex M3 has 16 registers (R0 - R15)
- * R0 - R12 are the general purpose registers
- * R0 - R12 general purpose registers grouped into registers R0 - R7 & higher registers (R8 to R12)
- * Cortex M3 has 2 stack pointers out of two only one is visible at a time
- * MSP [main stack pointer] :- Used by an OS kernel & exception handler
- * PSP [process stack pointer] :- Used by user application program for a code
- * R14 is the link register when subroutines are called return address is stored in link register.
- * R15 program counter used to control the program flow. Program counter stores the address of next instruction to be executed.
- * Cortex M3 has 5 special registers. XPSR, PRIMASK, FAULT MASK, BASEPRI, & control.

2) List the applications of ARM cortex M3 processor

- i) Low cost microcontroller :- The cortex M3 processor is ideally suited for low cost microcontroller; which are commonly used in consumer products. from toys to electrical appliances. It is a highly competitive market due to many well-known 8-bit & 16 bit microcontroller products on the market. Its lower power, high performance & ease of use advantages enable embedded developer to migrate

to 32-bit systems & develop products with the ARM architecture.

ii) Automotive:- Another ideal application for the cortex-M3 processor is in the automotive industry. The cortex-M3 processor has very high performance efficiency & low interrupt latency, allowing it to be used in real-time systems. The cortex-M3 processor supports up to 240 external vectored interrupts with a built-in interrupt controller with nested interrupt supports & optical mpv, making it ideal for highly integrated & cost sensitive automotive application.

iii) Data Communication:- The processor low power & high efficiency coupled with instruction in Thumb-2 for bit field manipulation makes the cortex-M3 ideal for many communication applications such as Bluetooth & Zigbee.

iv) Industrial control:- In industrial control applications, simplicity, fast response & reliability are key factors, again the cortex-M3 processor interrupts feature, low interrupt latency & enhanced fault-handling features make it a strong candidate in this area.

v) Consumer product:- In many consumer products a high performance microprocessor is used. The cortex-M3 being a small processor is highly efficient & low in power & supports an mpv enabling complex software to execute with providing robust memory protection.

3) Explain ARM cortex-M3 Program Status Register in detail.

The PSR's are sub divided into three status registers.

- i) Application Program Status Register [APSR]
- ii) Interrupt Program Status Register [IPSR]
- iii) Execution Program Status Register [EPSR]

The three PSRs can be accessed together or separately using the special register access instructions MSR & MRS, when they are accessed as a collective item the name XPSR is used.

We can read the PSRs using the MRS instructions we can also change the APSR using the MSR but EPSR & IPSR are read only for example

MRS R0, APSR : Read Flag state into R0

MRS R0, IPSR : Read Flag state into R0

MRS R0, EPSR : Read flag state into R0

MSR APSR R0 : write flag state

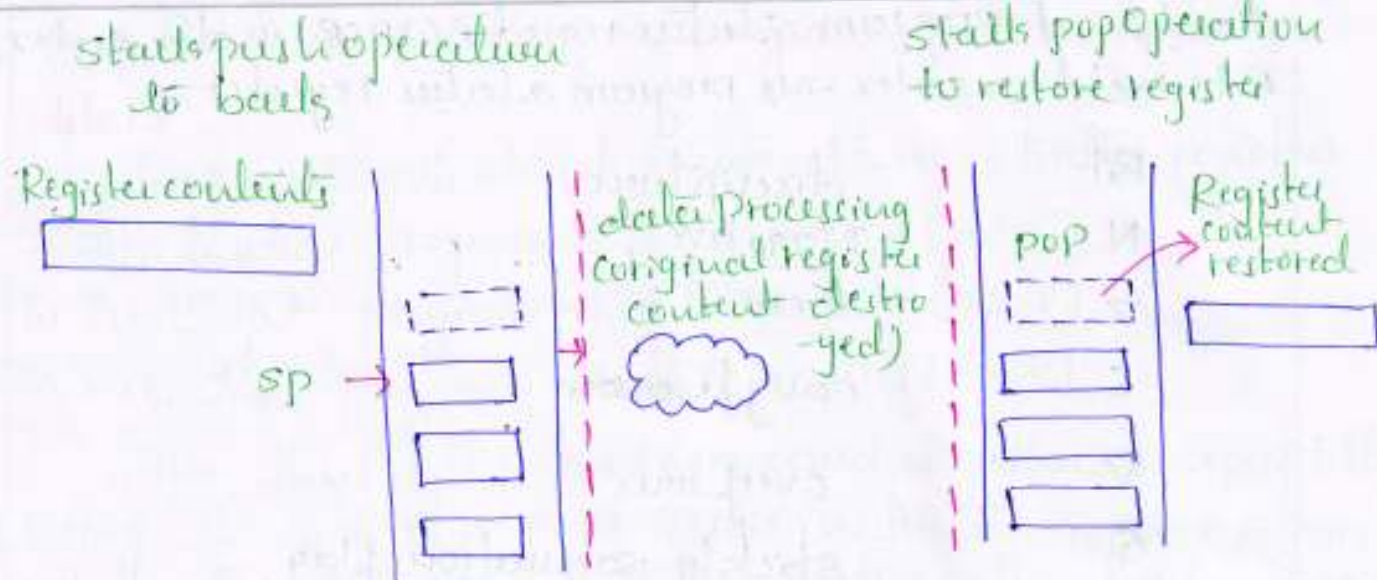

4) Explain stack push & pop operation in cortex-m3 with the help of neat diagram

Stack is the memory usage model. It is simply part of the system memory & a pointer register is used to make it work as a first-in-last-out buffer. The common use of a stack is to save register contents before some data processing task is done.

When doing push & pop operations the pointer register commonly called stack pointer, is adjusted automatically to prevent next stack operations from corrupting previous stacked data. It is not necessary to use both SPs. Simple applications can purely on the MSP. The SPs are used for accessing stack.



memory processor such as push & pop.

In cortex m3 the instructions for accessing stack memory are push & pop. The assembly language syntax is as follows

PUSH {R0}; $R13 = R13 - 4$; then memory [R13] = R0

POP {R0}; $R0 = \text{memory}[R13]$; then $R13 = R13 + 4$

The cortex m3 uses a few designing stack arrangement. The SP decrements when new data is stored in the stack. push & pop are usually used to save register content to stack memory at the start of a subroutine & then restore the register from stack at the end of the system subroutine.

PUSH {R0-R7, R12-R14}: save register

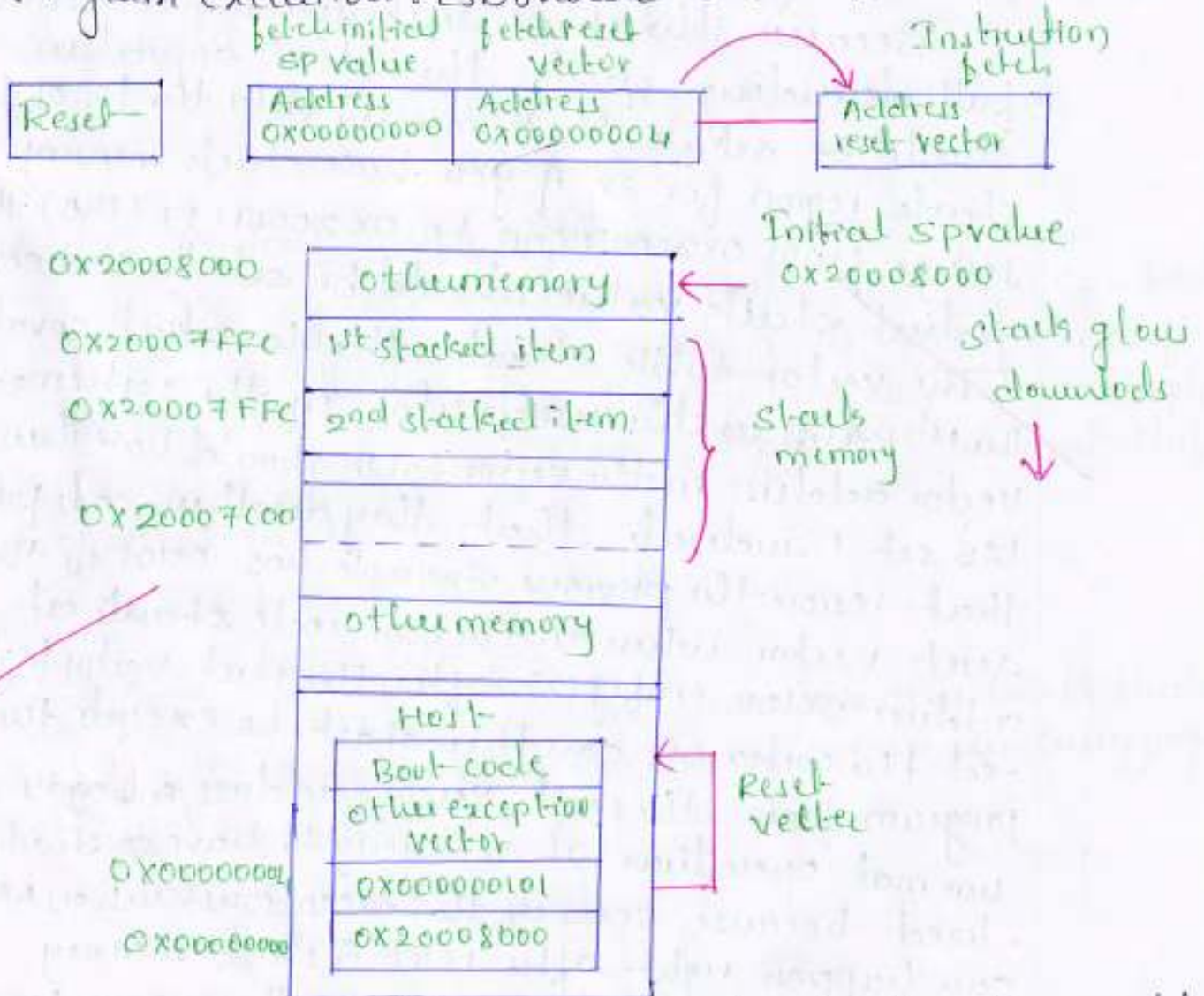
POP {R0-R7, R12, R14}: Restore register

BX R14

: Return to calling function.

5) Explain reset sequence with the help of memory map.
After the processor exits reset, it will read 2 word from memory.

- * Address $0x00000000$; starting value of R13 (the sp)
- * Address $0x00000004$; Reset-vector (the starting address of Program execution: LSB should be set to 1 to indicate



Arm processor executed program code starting from address $0x0$ further more the vector table in previous devices was instructions have to put a branch instruction there is so that your exception handler can be put in another location

In the cortex m3 the initial value for the msp is put at the beginning of the memory map, followed by vector table, which contains vector address value in addition, the content of the vector table address value not branch instructions. The 1st vector table is the reset vector, which is 2nd side of data fetched by the processor after reset.

Because the stack instruction in cortex m3 is full descending stack, the initial sp value should be set to the 1st memory after the top of the stack region for ex. if you have stack memory range from 0x20007000 to 0x2000FFFF (1KB). The initial stack value should be set to 0x20008000.

The vector table stands after the initial sp value. The 1st vector is the reset vector. In the cortex m3 vector address in the vector table should have the LSB set 1 indicate that they are thumb code for that region. The previous example has 0x101 in the reset vector whereas the boot code starts at address 0x100 in fig(2). After the reset vector fetched the cortex m3 can then start to execute the program from the reset vector address & begin normal operation. It is necessary to have sp initialized because some of the exceptions (such as NMI) can happen right after reset & stack memory could be required for handler of these exceptions.
