

CONTRACTOR/FREELANCER SERVICES AGREEMENT

The present Framework Contractor/Freelancer Agreement (“Agreement”) is entered into as of 6th June ,2022 (“Effective Date”), BETWEEN:

Hereinafter referred to as (the “**Company**”),

And
Sana Attar

Herein after referred to as (the “**Contractor/Freelancer**”)Jointly, the Company and the Contractor/Freelancer shall be referred to as the Parties.

PURPOSE & SCOPE:

The Company and the Contractor/Freelancer wish to set forth the terms and conditions regarding the services that the Company has a need for and that the Contractor/Freelancer will perform.

In consideration of the above, the parties **AGREE** as follows:

1. STATEMENT OF WORK & SERVICES

1.1 Any and all services provided by the Freelancer/Contractor under this Agreement (the “**Services**”) will be described in the written Statement of Work(s) (“**Statement of Work**”). Each Statement of Work will specifically describe the Services to be performed, deliverables, performance, criteria, milestones, fees, payment schedule and which, along with this Agreement, will govern Contractor/Freelancer provision of Services for the Company.

1.2 Each Statement of Work will expressly refer to this Agreement, will form a part of this Agreement, and will be subject to the terms and conditions contained herein. A Statement of Work may be amended only by a signed (by each party's authorized signatory) and written agreement of the parties. Nothing in this Agreement will preclude the Company from retaining the services of other persons or entities undertaking the same or similar functions, or from independently developing or acquiring materials or services that are similar to or competitive with the Services.

1.3 The Contractor/Freelancer will perform the services described in each Statement of Work in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in each Statement of Work and this Agreement. Unless otherwise agreed by the Company, Contractor/Freelancer will determine, in sole discretion, the manner and means by which the Services are accomplished, subject to the requirement that at all times Contractor/Freelancer complies with applicable law and any Company policies.

2. SUBCONTRACTING

2.1 The Contractor/Freelancer may not subcontract any of the Services without the Company's prior written consent and approval. If the Company consents to a particular subcontract, Contractor/Freelancer shall assume the same liability and responsibility for that subcontractor's conduct and performance as if Contractor/Freelancer performed all of the subcontractor's services. In particular but not limited to obligations regarding liability, confidentiality, intellectual property, data protection, anti-bribery, anti-corruption, and other suitable conduct. Contractor/Freelancer will ensure that the subcontractor enters into direct undertakings with Contractor/Freelancer regarding these obligations. The Company will not accept or be responsible for any additional fees, costs or charges with regard to any subcontract. Contractor/Freelancer will continue to be bound by all the obligations in this Agreement and will invoice the Company and be responsible for the remuneration of the subcontractor.

3. INDEPENDENT SERVICE PROVIDER

3.1 The Contractor/Freelancer is an independent service provider acting in this capacity with the Company and for the purposes of this Agreement. The Contractor/Freelancer shall not be considered an employee, worker, personnel, agent or partner of the Company. The Contractor/Freelancer shall not be entitled to local law or statutory benefits payable to employees, including but not limited to retirement, pension benefits, social security contributions, gratuity payments; time off, vacation, holiday, or illness, sickness payments; participation in any plans, arrangements or distributions made by the Company as it relates to bonus, stock options, profit sharing, insurance or similar benefits; or any other any end-of-service benefits payable to an employee or worker.

3.2 The Contractor/Freelancer has no authority to contact on behalf of the Company or to bind and engage the Company or to incur any liability on behalf of the Company, and will make such absence of authority clear in its dealings with any third parties.

3.3. This Agreement constitutes a provision of services and not an employment contract or employment of any sort. Contractor/Freelancer is solely responsible for (a) payment of all taxes, salaries, benefits, national insurance premiums, social security contributions, withholding taxes, workers' compensation, unemployment and disability insurance, and any other liability, deduction, contribution, assessment or claim arising from or made in connection with the performance of the Services required by any government agency or any other competent authority; and
(b) compliance with all applicable labor and employment requirements with respect to contractor/Freelancer self-employment, sole proprietorship or other form of business organization. Contractor will report to all applicable government agencies as income all

compensation received by the Company pursuant to this Agreement.

3.4 In the event where the Contractor/Freelancer decides to employ (“Contractor Employees”), the Contractor/Freelancer shall comply with all local, own laws concerning wage payments, withholdings, social and employment benefits, including taxation requirements for its employees. Contractor/Freelancer and Contractor/Freelancer employees are not employees of the Company. The Contractor/Freelancer shall be exclusively responsible for all labor law and related matters, required compliance, wage and benefit and other similar obligations for itself and for its employees. Contractor/Freelancer hereby indemnifies, defends and holds harmless the Company, and its Representatives. For the purposes of this Agreement, “Representative” means the employees, officers, directors, agents and professional advisors of the Party’s or its Affiliates.

3.5 This Agreement does not constitute joint employment and Contractor/Freelancer shall, with respect to its employees, be responsible for all employment functions including but not limited to hiring, firing, supervision, withholding federal, state and local income taxes, paying Social Security taxes, unemployment insurance and maintaining workers’ compensation insurance coverage in an amount and under such terms as required by local law. The parties further acknowledge and agree that any personnel of Contractor/Freelancer assigned to the Company’s account shall have no rights or entitlements to any of Company’s employee benefit plans.

3.6 Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and hold the Company harmless from and against any and all losses, damages, claims, demands, suits, and liabilities that arise out of or result from: (i) the classification of the Contractor/Freelancer or any of the Contractor/Freelancer agents, servants, or employees as an employee of the Company; or (ii) claims that Contractor Personnel are entitled to rights and privileges in any Company benefits or benefit plans, or social welfare entitlements.

4. NON-COMPETE & NON-SOLICITATION

4.1 During the term of this Agreement, and for a period of twelve (12) months after termination of this Agreement, Contractor/Freelancer agrees not to solicit for employment any Company employee without Company's prior written consent.

4.2 During the term of this Agreement and for a period of twelve (12) months after termination of this Agreement, the Company agrees not to solicit directly or indirectly those Contractors, employees responsible for providing the Services to Company.

5. FEES & PAYMENT

5.1 The Company agrees to pay the Contractor/Freelancer the fees stipulated in the Statement of Work pursuant to the terms set forth therein. The Contractor/Freelancer agrees that, if specified in the Statement of Work, the Company's obligations to pay will be subject to the completion of Services or achievement of milestones or Company's acceptance. Payment terms shall be included in the Statement of Work.

5.2 During the term of this Agreement and for a period of twelve (12) months after termination of this Agreement, the Company agrees not to solicit directly or indirectly those Contractors, employees responsible for providing the Services to Company.

5.3 If the Employee absents himself/herself from or abandons the training or service with the Company or refuses to serve the Company after the training or abandons such service before completion of the aforesaid two (2) year period or if the training or the service of Employee during the said two (2) year period is terminated by the Company for any misconduct by the Employee or other such similar reason, the Employee undertakes, without prejudice to any other rights and remedies of the Company, to pay to the Company, by way of reasonable compensation for the breach of Employee's obligations and not by way of penalty, an amount of INR 1,46,800/- (One Lac Forty Six thousand Eight Hundred Only) on pro-rata basis.

6. REPRESENTATIONS & WARRANTIES

6.1 Contractor/Freelancer represents and warrants:

- (i) That all Services will be performed in a professional manner, in compliance with the provisions of this Agreement, and will be of a quality conforming to the highest standards generally accepted in Contractor/Freelancer's industry.
- (ii) All Services deliverables shall conform in all respects with the Statement of Work and/or any additional specifications, as applicable.

- (iii) The Services and any deliverables will be original work of authorship, will not be injurious, scandalous, libelous, obscene or an invasion of privacy and will not infringe upon any copyright, patent, trade secret or other proprietary right, or misappropriate any trade secret of any third party. This will not apply to those Services and deliverables or any portion thereof identified by Contractor in a Statement of Work as that of a third party.
- (iv) It has neither assigned nor otherwise entered into an agreement by which it purports to assign or transfer any right, title or interest to any deliverables that would conflict with its obligations under this Agreement.
- (v) It is not a party to any other existing agreement which would prevent Contractor/Freelancer from entering into this Agreement or which would adversely affect this Agreement.
- (vi) With respect to any Services and/or any deliverables identified by Contractor/Freelancer as belonging to a third party Contractor represents and warrants that it has the right to license such Services and/or deliverables to the Company.

7. LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION

7.1 Contractor/Freelancer shall indemnify the Company from, and defend Company against, any and all expenses damages, liabilities, losses, penalties, fines, expenses and costs (including attorneys' fees and expenses as reasonably incurred) arising out of or relating to:

- (i) Any claim by a third party that the Services or any deliverable infringes upon the patent, copyright, trademark, trade secret or other intellectual property rights of any third party.
- (ii) An act or omission by Contractor/Freelancer in its capacity as an employer or implied employer of a person providing Services and any aspect of the employment relationship or its termination (including claims for breach of an expressed or implied contract of employment).
- (iii) Any amounts including taxes, interest, and penalties assessed against the Company which are obligations of Contractor/Freelancer.
- (iv) Personal injury, death, or damage to tangible personal or real property in any way incident to, or in connection with or arising out of the act or omission of Contractor/Freelancer, its employees, contractors, or agents in performing the Services.
- (v) Any claim arising out of or relating to any obligation imposed by any government authority and/or court of law on the Company to pay any withholding taxes, social security, unemployment or disability insurance, employees' retirement and/or pension benefits or similar items in connection with compensation received by Contractor pursuant to this Agreement
- (vi) Any claim arising out of the disclosure or use of Information. And,
- (vii) any breach of its covenants, representations and warranties. Contractor/Freelancer shall be responsible for any costs and expenses incurred by the Company in connection with the enforcement of this Clause

7.2 The Company will promptly notify Contractor/Freelancer in writing of the claim, allow Contractor/Freelancer to control the defense, and reasonably cooperate with Contractor/Freelancer in the defense and any related settlement negotiations. In addition to any defense provided by Contractor/Freelancer, the Company may, at its expense, retain its own legal counsel. And if Contractor/Freelancer does not promptly assume the Company's defense against such claim, the Company reserves the right to undertake its own defense at Contractor/Freelancer expense.

8. TERM & TERMINATION

8.1 This Agreement shall come into force on the Effective Date and shall continue until terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. Company may terminate any Statement of Work at any time for any reason upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to the Contractor/Freelancer.

8.2 Either party may terminate a Statement of Work upon written notice to the other party for a material breach by the other party, which remains uncured after five (5) days from the breaching party's receipt of written notice thereof. Ownership of deliverables and any licenses granted by this Agreement, or a Statement of Work will not be affected or limited by termination. In the event of termination for convenience, Company will pay Contractor/Freelancer for all accepted Services and reimbursable expenses accrued as of the effective date of termination of a Statement of Work.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY

9.1 For purposes of this Agreement, (“Confidential Information”) shall mean information or material proprietary to the Company or designated as confidential by the Company, as well as information about which the Contractor/Freelancer obtains knowledge or access, through or as a result of this Agreement (including information conceived, originated, discovered or developed in whole or in part by Contractor/Freelancer hereunder).

9.2 Confidential Information does not include: a) information that is or becomes publicly known without restriction and without breach of this Agreement or that is generally employed by the trade at or after the time the Contractor/Freelancer first learns of such information; b) generic information or knowledge which the Contractor/Freelancer would have learned in the course of similar employment or work elsewhere in the trade; c) information the Contractor/Freelancer lawfully receives from a third party without restriction on disclosure and without breach of a nondisclosure obligation; d) information the Contractor/Freelancer rightfully knew prior to receiving such information from the Company to the extent such knowledge was not subject to restrictions on further disclosure; or (e) information the Contractor/Freelancer develops independent of any information originating from the Company.

9.3 The following information will constitute Confidential Information of the Company and should not be disclosed to third parties: the deliverables, discoveries, ideas, concepts, software in various states of development, designs, drawings, specifications, techniques, models, data, source code, source files and documentation, object code, documentation, diagrams, flow charts, research, development, processes, procedures, “know-how”, marketing techniques and materials, marketing and development plans, customer names and other information related to customers of the Company, price lists, pricing policies and financial information, this Agreement and the existence of this Agreement, and any work assignments authorized or issued under this Contract. Freelancer/Contractor will not use Company’s name, likeness, or logo (the Company’s “Identity”), without the Company’s prior written consent.

9.4 The Parties hereby agree that during the term hereof and at all times thereafter, and except as specifically permitted herein or in a separate writing signed by the Company, the Freelancer/Contractor shall not use, commercialize or disclose Confidential Information to any person or entity. Upon termination, or at any time upon the request of the the Company, the Contractor/Freelancer shall return to the Company, in the extent possible, all Confidential Information, including all notes, data, reference materials, sketches, drawings, memorandums, documentations and records which in any way incorporate Confidential Information.

9.5 With respect to any information, knowledge, or data disclosed to the Company by the Contractor/Freelancer, the Contractor/Freelancer warrants that they have full and

unrestricted right to disclose the same without incurring legal liability to third parties, and that the Company shall have full and unrestricted right to use and publish the same as it may see fit. Any restrictions on Company's use of any information, knowledge, or data disclosed by Contractor/Freelancer must be made known to Company as soon as practicable and in any event agreed upon before the start of any work.



10. DATA PROTECTION

10.1 The Services provided by the Contractor/Freelancer may require the processing of Personal Data (as defined below), Contractor/Freelancer shall process all Personal Data in accordance with, where and as applicable, the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (“GDPR”) on data protection and privacy and all other applicable data protection laws “Including the California Consumer Privacy Act” (“Data Protection Laws”). “Personal Data” will have the meaning set forth in Article 4 of the GDPR, or as such term is defined under the laws of any territory with jurisdiction over this Agreement related to the protection of Personal Data. This clause shall apply to any subcontractors and employees that the Contractor/Freelancer may engage with.

10.2 Contractor/Freelancer will fully comply with any reasonable instructions from and on behalf of the Company regarding the processing of the Personal Data. The parties will inform each other immediately of any suspected or confirmed Personal Data breaches or unauthorized or unlawful processing, loss, or destruction of, or damage to Personal Data processed by a party in connection with Contractor/Freelancer provision of the Services. To the extent that the Services consist of the development of software, Contractor will develop the software in compliance with Data Protection Laws.

10.3 Without prejudice to the generality of this clause relating to data protection, Contractor/Freelancer will and ensure that its subcontractors and employees will:

- (i) Cooperate fully with the Company in order to enable the Company’s compliance with the obligations pursuant to Data Protection Laws and the obligations defined therein.
- (ii) Implement and maintain appropriate technical and organizational measures against unauthorized and unlawful processing of Personal Data and against accidental loss and destruction of or damage to Personal Data;
- (iii) Process any Personal Data disclosed to the Contractor/Freelancer by or on behalf of the Company only if for the purposes of providing the Services; and for the purposes for which that Personal Data was obtained and is processed by the Company;
- (iv) Provide evidence of Contractor/Freelancer compliance with obligations pursuant to Data Protection Laws when the Company may reasonably require
- (v) Upon request from data subject in relation to access, rectification or erasure and notification from the Company, enable the Company to comply with said request.

10.4 Contractor/Freelancer understands and agrees that the Company may carry out

monitoring of communications facilities use by Contractor/Freelancer (email supplied by Company, phone, mobile phone and computer communication) to monitor, prevent, detect or investigate any possible unauthorized use of Company's communications systems, wrongdoing or noncompliance with Company practices and procedures by Contractor/Freelancer, its employees, subcontractors. The Company will collect and process Contractor's PersonalData in accordance with its privacy notice and applicable laws.

11. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND OWNERSHIP

11.1 The Intellectual Property rights and obligations are included in Exhibit B attached to this Agreement.

12. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

12.1 IN NO EVENT WILL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT, EVEN IF THE PARTY HAS BEEN INFORMED IN ADVANCE OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION, EACH PARTY'S MAXIMUM LIABILITY WILL NOT EXCEED THE UNDISPUTED OUTSTANDING BALANCES OWED TO CONTRACTOR.

13. NO ASSIGNMENT

13.1 Contractor/Freelancer may not assign, transfer, delegate or subcontract this Agreement or any of the services, in whole or in part, without the Company's express prior written consent. Any attempt to assign or subcontract this Agreement, without such consent, will be void. Subject to the foregoing, this Agreement will bind and benefit the parties and their respective successors and assigns.

14. REMEDIES

14.1 Except as expressly set forth in this Agreement, the exercise by Company of any of its remedies under this Agreement will not be deemed an election of remedies and will be without prejudice to its other remedies under this Agreement or available at law or in equity or otherwise. The Company shall have the right to enforce this Agreement and any of its provisions by injunction, specific performance or other equitable relief, to the extent permissible under applicable laws.

15. SEVERABILITY

15.1 Except as expressly provided herein, in the event that any term or condition of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in whole or in part, the offending term or condition shall be deemed rewritten to effectuate the intent of the Parties to the greatest extent possible without being invalid, illegal or unenforceable, and no other term of the Agreement shall be in any way affected thereby.

16. LAW AND JURISDICTION

16.1 This Agreement and any dispute arising out of or in connection with it shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of Japan. The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of Japan shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Agreement or its subject matter.

17. ENTIRE AGREEMENT & AMMENDMENTS

17.1 This Agreement and the SOW constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties relating to the matters discussed herein and supersedes all prior communications and agreements between the Parties with respect thereto. Each Party acknowledges that (a) upon entering into this Agreement, it does not rely, and has not relied, upon any representation (whether negligent or innocent), statement or warranty made or agreed to by any person (whether a Party or not) except those expressly set out in this Agreement (including SOW); and (b) the only remedy available in respect of any misrepresentation or untrue statement made to it shall be a claim for damages for

breach of contract under this Agreement.

17.2 No term of any Statement of Work will be deemed to amend the terms of this Agreement unless a Statement of Work references a specific provision in this Agreement and provides that the Statement of Work is amending only that specific provision of this Agreement and only with respect to Services performed pursuant to such Statement of Work. This Agreement may be amended, modified, or waived only with the mutual written consent of the Parties hereto. Subject to the limitations set forth in this Agreement, this Agreement will inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the Parties and their respective successors-in-title and assigns.

18. NOTICES

18.1 All notices hereunder will be given in writing, will refer to this Agreement and will be personally delivered or sent by overnight courier, electronic mail, or registered or certified mail (return receipt requested) to the address set forth in this Agreement

19. EXECUTION

19.1 This Agreement may be executed electronically and in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument

EXHIBIT B: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND OWNERSHIP

This Exhibit for Intellectual Property Rights and Ownership is executed pursuant to all of the terms and conditions of Contractor Agreement dated as of 6th June,2022, between Company and Contractor/Freelancer (the **“Agreement”**)

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

“Intellectual Property” means any invention, technical information, data, computer software and all documentation thereof including without limitation source code, data base, improvement, design, copyrightable work, trademark or know-how which (1) is conceived, reduced to practice, authored, or developed by Contractor/Freelancer solely or jointly with the Company; (2) during the term, or in contemplation, of the Agreement; and (3) relates to the Field.

Contractor/Freelancer will promptly disclose to the Company all Property.

OWNERSHIP OF PROPERTY

Property, whether or not patentable, copyrightable or protectable as a trademark or trade secret, all proprietary rights therein, and all material objects related to the Property and produced for the Company’s benefit or at its request shall be exclusively owned by the Company. All works specially ordered or commissioned by the Company which may qualify as a work made for hire under the copyright law shall be considered a work made for hire, and the Company shall be the author and exclusive owner of such works.

Contractor/Freelancer hereby agrees to assign all such works made for hire and all copyright rights therein to the Company.

Contractor/Freelancer agrees that Company will own all patents, inventor’s certificates, utility models or other rights, copyrights or trade secrets covering the deliverables contained in the Agreement or it’s Statement of Work and will have full rights to use the deliverables without claim on the part of Contractor/Freelancer for additional compensation and without challenge, opposition or interference by Contractor/Freelancer and Freelancer will, and will cause each of its Personnel to, waive their respective moral rights therein. Contractor/Freelancer will sign any necessary documents and will otherwise assist the Company in securing, maintaining and defending copyrights or other rights to protect the Deliverables in any country.

ASSIGNMENT OF TITLE

Contractor/Freelancer will assign, and does hereby assign, all right, title and interest in any Property and all proprietary rights therein to the Company and will assist the Company and sign all lawful documents for obtaining and perfecting the proprietary rights for the Property worldwide. All attorney fees and government fees relating to the proprietary rights shall be paid by the Company. The Company shall be under no obligation to obtain, maintain or enforce any patent, copyright or trademark.

PRE-EXISTING INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Contractor/Freelancer will not use any Contractor/Freelancer or third party Pre-Existing Intellectual Property in connection with this Agreement or the Services included in the Statement of Work unless Contractor/Freelancer has the right to use it for the Company's benefit. If Contractor/Freelancer is not the owner of such Pre-Existing Intellectual Property, Contractor/Freelancer will obtain from the owner any rights as are necessary to ensure compliance with this Agreement.
