In the field of Technical Education, we have presented nearly 5500+ Engineering Graduates to serve the society. In spite of its rural location, the college has played a significant role in imparting quality education and it has been striving hard to provide holistic education by adopting an integrated approach that blends extracurricular activities, spiritual values, with the regular academics. Peaceful campus spread on over an area of 79 acres is highly conducive to undisturbed learning. At present, 59 faculty members, 14 faculty having Ph.D. from different premier institutions are working and 727 students are pursuing their studies at various levels. The NAAC peer team has visited our institution on 18th and 19th December 2018 for Assessment and Accreditation and our college has been accredited at A grade by NAAC. NBA expert Team has visited our college on 17th – 19th May, 2019 and all UG programs are accredited by NBA. Further, NBA compliance report was evaluated by expert team on 9th July, 2022 for extension of NBA accreditation. Computer Science & Engineering and Electronics & Communication programs are accredited for full validity of 6years i.e. up to 30th June, 2025. Our college has received Permanent Affiliation status from Visvesvaraya



Technological University, Belagavi and recently received 2(f) & 12B status recognition by UGC New Delhi under UGC act 1956.

This year our college is recognized as Life member for Board of IT Education Standards (BITES) Bangaluru. Dr.S.C. Kamate Principal, Dr.S.N.Topannavar, Prof. S.V. Manjaragi, and Pramod V Patil, Placement Officer have attended BITES annual Convention at Infosys campus, Mysuru and signed a MoU for training, placements and academic collaborations.

LIBRARY

The college library is stacked with more than 39,227 volumes, 9,962 Titles, 52 periodicals & Digital Library supported by VTU e-consortium with access to 9,811 referred National & International e-Journals & 16,800 e-Books. Learning material is upgraded every year as per the requirement of AICTE & VTU Belagavi. So far, more than Rs.1.45 crore is invested for procurement of books and periodicals including International Journals. The reference section of library is kept open up to late night hours during the examination period for the benefit of students. For this academic year 2022-23 we have invested worth Rs. 1,35,000/- for addition of 890 volumes for procurement of library books. Book Bank Scheme is introduced to provide complete set of books at the beginning of semester to all the students. The seating capacity of reference section in the library is 150 students at a time. e-Lib software V-17.2. is introduced for all library transactions.


