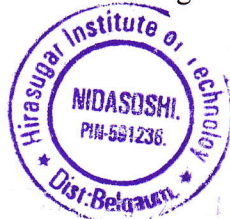
With the help of Borgal village people's feedback and their own observations, we the collage staff and students made the list of basic needs of the village. We observed & recorded the basic infrastructure such as water supply, electricity, roads, banks, health centers etc. The purpose of surveying the village is to assess the pace, process and pattern of rural development by means of repeated survey in the selected Borgal village. With the observations of people and from our collage survey team made the following notable observations.

Observations made during Village & Household Survey of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Going through the process of survey, we came across so many problems like

- 1) Pure drinking water supply to most of the houses. The common observations by our team are scarcity of water supply in summer season is major problem and wastage of water in rainy season.
- 2) Drainage systems are not available, due to which many diseases may spread from person to person.
- 3) Most of the streets are not having roads or not repaired.
- 4) Toilet facility not available for most of the houses this may causes many diseases.
- 5) Sewage facility is not available.
- 6) Community hospital facilities are not available for this they have to travel for other villages.
- 7) Continuous Electricity supply is not available and street light facilities may be improved.
- 8) Government high school is not there and no playground is available.
- 9) Benefits of Pension schemes are not taken by many beneficiaries. People of village are having lack of knowledge about pension schemes due to which many people are not having pension facilities.
- 10) Unemployment in youths is the major problem in the village. Most of them are not having their higher education and skill up gradation.
- 11) Bank facilities are not available for most of the people and not aware of government schemes and facilities.
- 12) Animal husbandry and dairy facilities needs to be improved.
- 13) People with handicapped problems face many problems due to the lack equipments.

These are common problems listed according to the observation made during survey at Borgal.




Summaries of observations made during Village & Household Survey of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

From the description, we were able to analyze few points on which the village is lacking behind and needs to be worked upon.

- 1) Pure Drinking Water-supply of drinking water can be made available to all the houses.
- 2) Electricity Supply-Continuous electricity facility can be made available to farmers to improve their earnings.
- 3) Health – proper hospital facility can be made available in the village which gives some benefits under the different government schemes.
- 4) Roads – The roads are very narrow and may be the quality of roads can be improved.
- 5) Education System – There is a desperate need for higher educational establishment in the village.
- 6) Toilet facilities, sewage treatment, waste collection etc must be made in appropriate way and maintenances of the above facilities for betterment of their lifestyle & health.
- 7) Banking Facilities-banking facilities can be improved through the awareness and educating the people about the various government schemes and facilities.

There may be many more problems for which solutions might be available for the betterment of people & development of village.

Observations made during Village & Household Survey of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Going through the process of survey, we came across so many problems like

- 1) Water supply to most of the houses. This can also be caused due to scarcity of water. In some places due to overuse of water in only some particular places it becomes difficult for the people in other places. Now a days the overuse of water is increasing day by day and people are using an extra amount than needed. Pollution of water also plays an important factor behind the water scarcity.
- 2) Drainage systems are not covered due to which many diseases spread over person to person.
- 3) Roads are also to be repaired.
- 4) Toilet facility - some homes have no private washroom. They use common washrooms.
- 5) Sewage – It makes degradation of environment, agricultural fields and also causes contamination. This makes the environment unhygienic.
- 6) Lack of hospitality and nursing for the pregnant women. On the other hand the village has lack of maternity.
- 7) Electricity and street light facilities are less according our observation.
- 8) Lack of playground for children of the village. Due to which many of them play on roads.
- 9) Pension scheme – people of village lack knowledge about pension schemes due to which many people have money issues.
- 10) Unemployment of people – most of the people work in farm. They have agricultural knowledge but lack technological ones.
- 11) People with handicapped problems face much of problems due to the lack equipments.
